The official College uniform supplier is the Waverley Trading Co-operative. Most of the College's uniform requirements are supplied by the Trading Co-op. Those items not supplied by the Co-operative are available from the College Uniform Shop. Details of both operations are included in this information. Please find below a listing of the College's uniform requirements. **To avoid variations in school uniform it is necessary to purchase specified items from the Co-op or the College, not other stores. Where neither is designated, uniform items may be purchased from the Waverley Trading Co-op or a department store, etc.**

All students from Prep to Year 12 are required to have correct Swimming and Physical Education uniforms from the beginning of the school year.

OTHER

SECOND HAND ITEMS

A good range of second-hand uniform items, are available at the College Uniform Shop which operates between 3.00 and 4.00 pm on Wednesdays.

Second-hand items are in the cupboards on the left along the wall. If you wish to look through second-hand items please help yourself. Kindly ensure unwanted garments are folded neatly and returned to the correct shelf.

Selling Your Second-Hand Items

Second-hand items **can be sold for you**. Complete the 'Second Hand Uniform Shop Request To Sell' form, and include with items in a bag. You can price them yourself or leave it for staff to determine. Leave bag at Uniform Shop on Wednesdays or at the General Office, marked "Second-Hand Uniforms", with the completed form.

If there is no completed form with your name on it included in the bag, it will be assumed to be a donation to the College.

Once items are sold, 15% is deducted for services and expenses. The balance of sale will be credited to your College account in the next school term. An envelope containing the Uniform Shop sales docket will be stapled to your next invoice or statement showing the credit for the sale.

Donations of second-hand items are also welcome. Please mark "Donation" on bag containing items.

Items of school uniform accepted for resale in the uniform shop must be in excellent condition. Any uniform item that has any of the following problems cannot be accepted for sale:

- Uniform items with stains or marks of any kind
- Faded, stained or discoloured clothing
- Frayed collars or cuffs
- Torn or frayed seams, button holes, darts
- Worn spots on elbows of jumpers, knees of trousers
- Buttons missing
- Pockets torn or missing
- Mending or alterations that show
- Other rips or tears
- Hems undone

Please remove name tags or delete name. It would be appreciated if the size tag could be left on the garment.

SHOP PROCEDURES

Sales

If you cannot make it to the shop on Wednesday after school due to work or other commitments, here are some alternatives:

1. You may contact Dianne and arrange an appointment for a suitable time.
2. Students are able to call in on Wednesday afternoons to purchase items if you send a note (with sizing if required).
3. If you are certain of the size garment, item required or an order is on hold, you may send a note via the General Office requesting to have the item left at the General Office for your collection **upon payment**. This option should only be used in extreme circumstances.

Please present correct cash if at all possible, or a cheque made payable to Waverley Christian College. Total amount payable will be marked on the bag with the items requested.

It is suggested the time from 3.00 – 3.30 pm be used for collecting ordered items and browsing through second-hand items in order to ease congestion after 3.30 pm.

You need to have your child with you to try clothing before purchasing. We cannot exchange after an item has been purchased.

Uniform Staff are available to advise you with uniform requirements and sizes.

Payment

Payment can be made by:

1. Cash
2. Cheque made payable to Waverley Christian College
3. Eftpos. Voucher issued at Shop will be processed at General Office and verified, returned to Shop and purchase collected
4. Credit Card Payments. Authorisation form to be completed at shop. This will be processed at a later date by Accounts Department.
5. Receipts are only issued on request at the time of purchase.

HELPFUL HINTS

Pinafores

So students can obtain maximum wear from the pinafore, it can be adjusted in several ways:

1. Buttons and press studs can be altered at shoulders. This will take up quite a lot of length.
2. Put a tuck in the bib at waist-line.
3. Adjust hem.
4. Bib can be easily removed from skirt so it can be used for Secondary uniform.

Pinafores and skirts should be hand-washed and pressed.

Dresses

Dresses and skirts are to be worn at the appropriate length, i.e: kneecap to be fully covered when standing.

Blouses

If sleeves are too long, unstitch the seam between elbow area and almost to arm hole. Sew tuck towards inside for amount required, resew sleeve seam. Do not wash in very hot water, otherwise collars will bubble.

Track Pants

If waist it too wide but length is needed, put tuck in waist band.

Loop Ties

If broken, rethread with firm hat elastic.

Ties

Ties are hand washable.

Paint Stains from Art

Soak in warm water and scrub with detergent several times. Stain should come out. If 100% cotton, use chlorine bleach. If polyester, use all-fabric bleach such as Neon or Amway.

Whiteout on Uniforms

Try nail polish remover.

Name Tags

Please name all items of Uniform and be sure to remove old name labels from second-hand items.

White Shirts

If not purchasing from the Waverley Trading Co-op, short sleeve and **long** sleeve shirts both need to be purchased in January. Long sleeves are hard to obtain if you wait until winter.

CREDIT

Credit can only be given if prior arrangements are made with the Bursar.
