Annual Fee Increases

2020 annual fee increase has been kept to 3.5% in an effort by the Council to keep fees affordable for families.

Tuition Fees, Levies and Miscellaneous charges

Fees are invoiced on an annual basis and charged by 11 instalments from January to November to your statements. Account statements will be issued on a monthly basis. Additional charges not covered by this Fees and Levies Schedule may be invoiced as applicable to your child. Elective fees are invoiced per semester.

Methods of Payment

Annual fees paid in advance are acceptable and greatly assist the College. Direct debit is the expected payment method. These payments may be from your nominated bank account or credit card (fortnightly, monthly or quarterly). New families are required to be on the direct debit payment arrangement. The Direct debit form is available from Waverley Engage.

Fee Payment Options (one of the following) :

4x Quarterly Instalments

Due by 15th of February, April, July and October.

11x Monthly Instalments (DEFAULT PAYMENT OPTION)

Due by 15th of each month from January to November.

22x Fortnightly Instalments

Commencing on the third Thursday of January and concluding in November.

Camps and Excursions

School camps and excursions are required curriculum activities. These costs are generally not refundable except for medical reasons (with the presentation of a doctor's certificate) and other special circumstances.

The minimum refundable amount is \$20.

Camps, Sports, Excursion Funds (CSEF)

CSEF is a Victorian government allowance to assist low-income families with Health care cards or Pension cards. The allowance is applied to your account as a credit. For further information, please contact the Accounts Dept.

VET Course

All VET subjects incur additional charges. Contact your campus VET Co-ordinator for more information. VET course fee can range from \$1,000 - \$3,100.

Late withdrawal fee may be charged for any withdrawal past the acceptable cut off deadline.

Administration Fee

An administration fee will be applied to your school fees account should your direct debit be dishonoured. This is to recover the fee charged by the bank.

Late Payment and Overdue Accounts

Tuition fees and charges are due and payable on the due date as determined by the frequency of the payment plan selected.

Late payers are required to go on the direct debit payment arrangement.

The College is not responsible for any delay in receiving your payment.

Any family with an overdue account greater than one term outstanding will have their enrolment reviewed or suspended at the discretion of the Principal.

Parents are liable for all expenses, including contingent expenses such as debt collection commission and legal costs incurred by the College in pursuit of recovery of monies due from parents.

Parents are encouraged to contact the Accounts Department before overdue school fees become an issue. Payment plans can be arranged to prevent the need for external debt collection.

Withdrawal of Student Enrolment

As per the Terms and Conditions on the signed Application for Enrolment form, one full term's fee will be payable in lieu of a term's notice, in writing to the Principal. If a student is withdrawn at the insistence of the College (due to unsatisfactory behaviour or student conduct), parents remain liable for all fees and charges to the date of notification of the student's withdrawal from the College.

Commencement Date

If an enrolled student does not take up a confirmed place at the pre-arranged commencement date, a holding fee as determined by the Bursar may be payable. This holding fee is non-refundable and will not be offset against future tuition fees.

Leave of Absence

Planned temporary leave of absence from the College for one term or more must be submitted in writing to the Heads of School providing at least one month's notice. No tuition fee concession will be provided in such instances.

The College may hold enrolment places for absences over 12 months by charging a holding fee as determined by the Bursar.

Acceptance of Enrolment Fee

This non-refundable fee is payable to accept a place that is offered by the College and is charged as follows ;

1st Enrolment :	\$300
